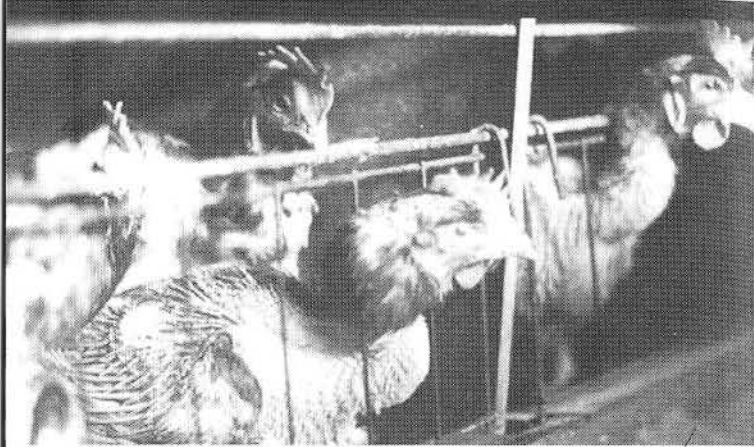

Since its formation the Animal Liberation Front has saved many thousands of animals from death and suffering. Its actions have also played an important part in the closing down of many animal abuse establishments through the tactic of economic sabotage.

The price paid by activists has been high. Many have been sent to prison for many years, and the average sentence is increasing.

The prisoners are imprisoned for selfless acts of compassion, born of the frustration of waiting for the rest of society to respect animals. They are not “terrorists” or “misguided”, their actions are an important part of the struggle for animal liberation, perhaps the most important part.

The ALF Supporters Group believes that such good people should not be abandoned to their fate, but deserve as much help and support as can be given to them. We send monthly cheques to each prisoner, pay for books, educational materials and help their visitors with the cost of visits. We encourage people to write letters to the prisoners to show solidarity and support. The Supporters Group also publish regular newsletters with information of relevance and general articles on the state of the animal liberation movement.

Activists are very rarely wealthy people. In fact the opposite is usually the case. Therefore, when they are fined, we do what we can to help with the financial burden. This support is extended to animal rights activists imprisoned for their actions on a demo or hunt sab.

Perhaps one day good people won't have to rescue animals from their prisons, only to end up in one themselves.
